

EXPECTATIONS UPON COMPLETION OF TREATMENT

Degree of Whitening

There is no definite way to predict how light your teeth will get. During the consultation, you will be shown before/after pictures of previous clients so that you may have an overall perspective on the kind of results we can achieve. In clinical studies, the whitening process has resulted in 7-9 shade changes (on the vita shade guide.) If there are questions regarding this issue, please discuss them with the dentist prior to signing the consent form. We cannot guarantee outcome – but we are partners with you, and will work diligently to arrive at acceptable levels of whiteness.

Relapse and Maintenance

Following the completion of the whitening procedure, it is normal to experience a slight degree of relapse within the first 24-48 hours. Through the normal staining process of day-to-day eating and drinking, you may experience gradual shade relapse. This will depend on the frequency of use of tobacco products, coffee, tea, red wine and other staining foods/drinks.
